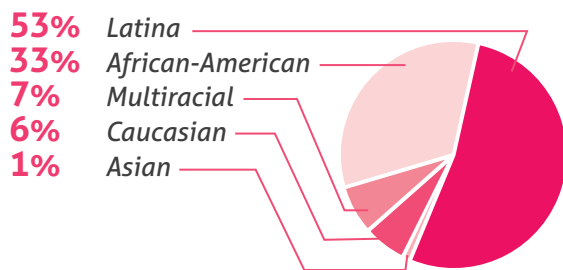

ETHNIC IDENTITY



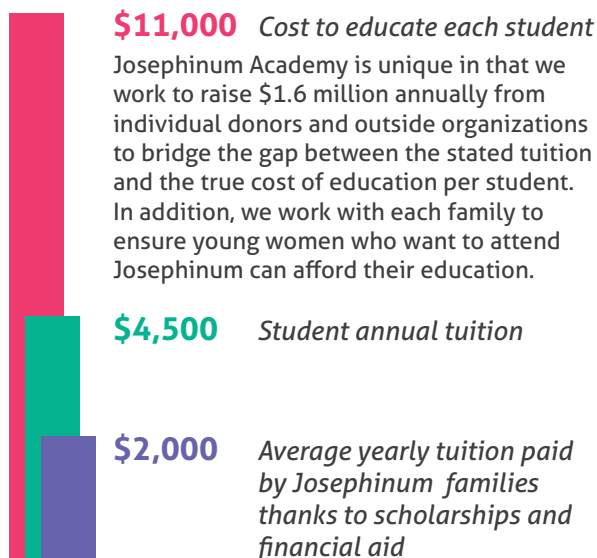

WHAT IS JOSEPHINUM ACADEMY?

Josephinum Academy is a high school for young women founded in 1890 in the Wicker Park neighborhood of Chicago. Josephinum offers an academically rigorous, Catholic college preparatory program that empowers its students to become confident, faith-filled leaders. Governed by an independent board of directors, the school became an official member of the Sacred Heart Network of Schools in 2011 and receives its educational direction from the Religious of the Sacred Heart.

Josephinum is unique because it offers personal attention that motivates each student to achieve her full potential. Josephinum is a close-knit community that offers a challenging academic experience and inspires the confident, individual expression and personal growth of each student.

Josephinum's academic program emphasizes critical thinking, analysis, and writing skills needed at the university level. Freshmen and sophomores complete a portfolio with a special defense of their work. Seniors complete a capstone project including a ten page position paper with an accompanying oral defense in front of a diverse panel of faculty and community volunteers.

PREPARING WOMEN FOR COLLEGE

Over the past five years at Josephinum:

- **100%** of our graduating seniors were accepted into colleges and universities.
- More than **90%** of our seniors have graduated on time.

In 2011:

- Over **\$1,600,000** in college scholarships were offered to seniors.
- **82** College Scholarships were offered to 20 of our senior students.

Since 2008, Josephinum's class valedictorian has received a **full ride** to her chosen university.
