



What is the FLSP program?

The Future Leaders Scholarship Program (FLSP) ensures that all girls have the right to a world-class, transformative, college-preparatory education. All FLSP applicants will demonstrate a strong commitment to academic success and active and positive school participation. Applicants automatically qualify if they meet the guidelines below. Scholarships will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. In addition, three scholarships at each level will be awarded solely on the basis of merit, and families of any income level are encouraged to apply. [Please click here for more information.](#)

Who can apply for a FLSP?

Any 8th grade student who is applying for entry to Josephinum Academy as a freshman and has met the [eligibility requirements](#).

Can I still apply for financial aid?

Applicants to the FLSP may still be eligible to receive financial aid. The [Financial Verification Form](#) that is filled out as part of the FLSP application also qualifies you for consideration. If the scholarship that is awarded does not meet a family's financial need, the applicant is welcome to request a financial aid assessment of their already submitted FACTS application.

Do I get the FLSP for 4 years?

Yes, the FLSP tuition discount will follow you through your four years at Josephinum. For example, if you receive a 100% FLSP scholarship, and the tuition increases in year 2, you will still receive a 100% tuition discount in year 2. You will lose your FLSP if you transfer out of Josephinum Academy.

Can I combine the FLSP with another scholarship award?

This is sometimes possible on a case by case basis, but always depends on the scholarship organization. FLSP award combined with any external scholarship cannot exceed current tuition. Any monies raised over the current year's tuition cannot be applied to non-tuition based fees (enrollment, uniform, etc) or any future year's tuition.

What GPA do I need to maintain in order to keep my FLSP?

You must maintain your GPA within the parameters of your FLSP contract. Each FLSP contract has guidelines for maintenance. For example, if you are awarded a 100% tuition discount, which requires a GPA of 3.5, you must maintain a GPA of 3.0 or above to keep your FLSP scholarship.

What happens if my family's financial situation changes after I've been awarded the FLSP?

An individual's FLSP award will not change even if the family's financial situation changes. Additional Financial Aid will be available on a case by case basis.

If I lose my FLSP because of my grades, behavior, etc. , and my grades, behavior, (...) improve, can I reapply?

No, FLSP awards are only awarded to 8th grade applicants.

What are the key dates for the FLSP scholarship process?

- December 1, 2016: Priority consideration application deadline
- January 14, 2017: Entrance Exam (8:00 a.m.)
- February 3, 2017: Priority consideration FLSP notifications

If any scholarships remain after priority consideration notifications, all subsequent applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis.

Once awarded, how long do I have to accept the FLSP award and enroll at Josephinum Academy before I lose my FLSP?

You will have 3 weeks from the date of your award notification letter to enroll at Josephinum Academy. Any awardee who has not enrolled within this time frame will forfeit the offered FLSP.

What are the key dates for the financial aid process?

If you have completed your Financial Aid application by January 14, you will be informed of any financial aid awards by February 3. Any subsequent applications will be notified 2 weeks following their Financial Aid Application. [Please click here for more information.](#)
