#### Comedy of Errors

Following quickly on the heels of January's The Importance of Being Earnest, and March's Her Story instillation, this spring, Josephinum Academy produced William Shakespeare's Comedy of Errors. Performed by David Fehr's 8th period acting class, the play was a semester-long project integrated into the structure of the class itself. Comedy of Errors tells the story of a young man named Antipholus (Veronica Oscilowicz) and his Man Friday: Dromio (Dani Oroczo) searching the town of Ephesus for their long lost twin brothers, who are coincidentally named Antipholus and Dromio (played respectively by Jasmine Manuel and Aimee Medina). Along the way the 15-character ensemble weaved a story full of love, frustration, silliness and confusion. The show was very successful, and the talk-back showed how much the students learned through the production experience. Comedy of Errors was the 6th full-length production at Josephinum in four years. The next show will be in January 2014.
