A few additional reminders:

- Health Forms: It is extremely important that we have updated information on all of our students including vaccination information. Ms. Letty will send out health forms to be completed by your student's primary doctor. Mandatory health requirements include:
 - 9th Graders
 - Full medical physical
 - Dental examination
 - 12th Graders
 - Two doses of MCV4 vaccine (meningococcal conjugate vaccine).
 Only one dose is required if the first dose was received at 16 years of age or older.
 - Athletes
 - Updated Physical on file


