### WHAT IS JO JAMBOREE 2019!

A free, indoor and outdoor, community festival for the whole family in support of health, wellness, sports and fitness.

### WHEN AND WHERE?

- Saturday, June 8th at Josephinum Academy (1501 N. Oakley Blvd., Chicago), 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. There is no rain date – Jo Jamboree will take place on June 8<sup>th</sup> rain or shine!
- There are clinics and activities taking place throughout the day. Please dress in shoes and attire that allow for physical activity.

### WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

#### **A REFILLABLE WATER BOTTLE.**

- A towel if you plan to participate in sports clinics or fitness classes
- A picnic blanket to eat or relax on the grass.
- Your bike - we have a bicycle clinic this year doing small repairs and tune-ups. If you bring a bike, please bring a lock. There is no bike riding permitted on school property.

### WHAT SHOULD I NOT BRING?

- Soccer or softball cleats
- Alcoholic beverages are not allowed
- Sorry – no pets.

### HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

It's free! Thanks to all of our sponsors and program hosts, there is no cost to enter Jo Jamboree 2019!, or to participate in any of the clinics or activities. Some food and drinks are available for a small fee (cash only).

## PARKING?

- Non-reserved street parking is typically available on surrounding side streets surrounding the school.
- Complimentary parking in a nearby indoor garage is reserved for Jo Jamboree guests on the Amita Sts Mary and Elizabeth Medical Center campus. The lot is at the corner of Claremont Ave. and Hirsch St. Entrance off of Claremont just south of the Medical Office Building. Please park on the 4th floor or higher (with exception of those needing the 1st floor handicapped spaces). Please DO NOT park in the patient lot at LeMoyne and Claremont.
- As we are a “downtown” campus, use of public transportation is always encouraged if walking isn’t an option. Josephinum (1501 N. Oakley) is located within a few short blocks of both the Western and Damen stops on the Blue Line. North Ave and Western Ave bus stops are even closer!
